

SAFE RESTART: WILDWOOD BASEBALL PARK

GENERAL STATEMENT


The guidelines and recommendations identified below represent practical best efforts to proactively keep our players, employees, fans, and community safe when attending events at Wildwood Baseball Park. These practices were compiled using the US Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Sheboygan County Safe Restart guidelines with an emphasis on social distancing, hygiene, minimizing human touch-point opportunities, and individual responsibility. The Sheboygan Athletic Club will continually review and adjust these guidelines based on the most updated recommendations from federal, state, and local health officials.

BALLPARK CLEANLINESS

- Seating areas and other high-traffic areas will be disinfected on a regular basis. This includes during and after games.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the ballpark.

FANS

- Fans are encouraged to check their temperature before attending a game. If a fan has a temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or greater, isn't feeling well, or has other symptoms, the Sheboygan A's ask that they not attend.
- Fans are encouraged to wear a face mask especially in areas where social distancing is more
 difficult such as the ticket window, concession stand, team store, and bathroom. There will be
 masks for sale in the Team Store.
- Household groups (those you live with) may sit together but must be 6 ft from the next household group. Fans may be asked by our ushers to move if they are too close to another group.



RESTROOMS

- The bathrooms attached to the Concessions Building will be for Sheboygan A's staff and players ONLY.
- The bathrooms attached to the Advanced Comfort Systems Sky Box/Press Box building will be available for everyone else.



TICKETS

- A limited number of tickets will be available based on regulations in place; the capacity is subject to change at any time.
- Season ticket holders will not receive a ticket booklet this year but will instead receive a pass/ card that needs to be shown at the ticket booth every game to gain access.
- We encourage fans to use a card payment rather than cash. However, cash will be accepted.

SEATING

- Every other row will be closed to enforce social distancing. Please do not cross these barriers or occupy these rows.
- Household groups (those you live with) may sit together but must be 6 ft from the next household group. You may be asked by our ushers to move if you are too close to another group.





CONCESSIONS

- There will be very limited concession items this year: pre-packaged items only, and they are subject to change.
- Cash will be accepted. If we are able to set-up an electronic pay system for the concession stand, we will encourage fans to use a card rather than cash.
- Fans are asked to throw away their own trash both during and after the game.



TEAM STORE

- There will be a limit of 1 family/individual in the team store at a time and is subject to change.
- We encourage fans to use a card payment rather than cash. However, cash will be accepted.
- Fans are asked to only touch items that they intend to purchase.

BALLPARK INTERACTIONS

- The act of hand shaking, high fives, fist bumps, and other physical contact are discouraged.
- The frequent use of hand sanitizer and/or hand washing is encouraged.
- If you must cough or sneeze, please do so in a napkin or into your elbow, and then sanitize.
- Fans will not be able to interact with players including but not limited autographs, photos, and any other contact.
